If you have any climbing vine plants on your property, please be advised that the vines must be trimmed back so they are not attached to any common wall or fence. All vines and plants in exclusive use areas must be kept neatly trimmed at all times!!!

PARKING REMINDER

Parking can be an issue within our community. To help ease this situation, Management is asking all residents to review the rules regarding parking. Also, remember to always inform all guests of the rules.

- Garages must be utilized for parking two vehicles.
- Parking boats, trailers, and motor homes is prohibited on all streets.
- Guests, including worker vehicles, must park in designated guest spaces and at raised curbs.
- Always allow a twenty-foot driving lane between parked vehicles when parking.
- Blocking any driveway, garage, or sidewalk is in direct violation of the City ordinance.
- Red curbs are Fire Lanes, blocking them can result in towing and fines from the City.
- Parking facing the wrong way is against the law and prohibited.
